As you are aware, the Board of Studies (BOS) meeting held last year was an insightful and productive discussion among all faculty members.

As we approach the next academic year, I kindly request that each of you reflect on the,

Challenges Faced in the Current Academic Year:

- **Time to cover all credits**: Limited time to adequately cover the entire curriculum within the allocated semester hours.
- **Pressure on students:** High academic workload leading to stress and difficulty in managing multiple courses and assignments.
- **Time allocated for extracurricular activities**: Insufficient time for students to engage in co-curricular and extracurricular activities, which are vital for holistic development.
- **Core enhancement**: Difficulty in enhancing core curriculum content to meet industry demands while maintaining academic rigor.
- Balancing theory and Experiential Learning components: Struggling to integrate sufficient practical experience alongside theoretical coursework.
- **Faculty workload**: Overburdening of faculty members with administrative duties and teaching responsibilities, affecting quality of instruction.
- **Assessment overload**: Too many assessments, leading to student burnout and not allowing sufficient time for in-depth learning.
- **Technology integration:** Challenges in effectively incorporating technology and online tools into the learning process, especially for hybrid courses.
- **Student engagement**: Ensuring active student participation in virtual or hybrid classes, leading to concerns about the quality of interaction.

Based on your experiences, it would be beneficial to convene another BOS (School wise) meeting to review and, if necessary, adjust the curriculum in the week of $28^{th} - 1^{st}$ April.

Please ensure that all key aspects are covered, and any necessary modifications are made to address the evolving needs of the students and academic requirements.
